Dear Fellow Citizens of Nunn:

I am Danny Joe Bagby. I prefer to be called Joe. I am asking you to consider me for the position of Mayor of the Town of Nunn, when you vote in the upcoming Recall Elections concerning the current Mayor.

The Town has not met many essential deadlines; this is an issue that needs to improve.
