The Town of Nunn Board of Trustees would like to invite you to be a part of round table meeting on June 9<sup>th</sup> 2009 at 7:00pm at the Nunn Community Center.

In the past there have been several meetings, some have been very informative and others not so much so. The intent of this meeting is to take all of the information that has been gathered in the past several months and have it presented in a public forum. This will be a round table meeting with 3 members of each group (Powertech and CARD). Each group will be allowed 20 minutes each for an opening statement. There will then be a round of questions expected to take 50 minutes, which will be submitted from the citizens and the Town Board to each group no later than June 5<sup>th</sup> for review. We will then close with a 10 minute summary from both sides. This event will be no longer than 2 hours and will be civil. Anyone that is not professional or is using profanity will be escorted out and will not be allowed to return. Picketing and/or signature gathering will not be allowed at this event. All comments and responses will be controlled and persons will be noticed by the mediator.

We feel our community has the most at stake and we want to take this opportunity to have both sides heard in their entirety. Here are a few of the concerns we would like your presentation to address: 1) Are there land owners that have the mineral rights and could profit from this proposed mining operation? 2) What are the concerns to the land owners that would like to block the mining operations? 3) What are the benefits of Uranium versus coal and how does this affect the "go green" theory? 4) How does this operation differ from those over seas that our country is dependent on? 5) Please explain the safety factors of mining in the US versus overseas mining. 6) What are the shipping concerns of uranium coming into our country and how will these compare to the shipments of this operation? 7) What safety precautions are being taken in regards to terrorist activities for this project versus the import of uranium. 8) There are many concerns over spills, what is the magnitude of the spills that are being associated with other projects compared to spills of imports or other mining and/or drilling operations?

As a concerned group of citizens the Town of Nunn would like these talks to address the above concerns with an emphasis on the proposed economic and safety concerns, (especially water) that this would pose an impact to the Town of Nunn, Weld County, the State of Colorado and to our great nation.
